Morning Drop Off

The tardy bell rings at 8:05 a.m. If a student is not in the classroom at that time, they are considered tardy and will need to get a tardy pass at the office.

Car riders can be dropped off at the front entrance or on the south field entrance each morning. **Please make sure you are dropping your child off on the side closest to the building in the front and south locations. The outside lanes are for through traffic only. This will ensure that no students are crossing in front of moving cars and will help keep our kids safe.**

All students may be dropped off as early as 7:25 am. Our tardy bell rings at 8:05 am and teachers pick up their students in the gym by 7:55 am. So, we highly encourage you to have your students on campus by 7:50 am each day. If a student is not in the classroom by 8:05 am, they are tardy.

Afternoon Pick Up

Students will be dismissed each afternoon at 3:20 pm. Car riders will be dismissed out the front doors and the south entrance doors only. Please make sure to communicate your car location with your student in order for them to know which exit to use. Bus students will be the only students allowed to exit the west doors. This keeps the amount of traffic in that location to a minimum.

Canyon Intermediate staff members continue to recognize students for meeting or exceeding our campus wide expectations! We hand out “Got Caught” coupons when we catch a student Cooperating, Achieving, Respecting, or Empowering. Each week, we draw 5 names from our CARE quilt and those students receive a “CIS Eagles CARE” purple bracelet. The bracelet will allow students to participate in fun activities throughout the year and serve as a visual reminder of the power of making good choices. IMPORTANT Dress Code Reminders

EARLY PICK UP PROCEDURES

All students must be picked up and signed out in the office. An early out will count as a partial day absence which is the same as a tardy when considering that the students are required to be here 90% of the school year. Only a full day of attendance, counts toward the 90%.

All parents are welcome at Canyon Intermediate. We need you to ring the doorbell at the front door, check in with your ID, get a visitor’s badge and we will help you get to where you need to go. Please wear your badge at all times while in the building.
