Hillside Birthday policy

We love to celebrate your children on their birthdays!! All students have their names called on the announcements on their special day and are asked to come to the office for a birthday pencil!

We do have some guidelines that we ask you to follow when bringing treats and invitations.

- *You are allowed to drop off treats (they do not have to be food!) for your child to hand out, but parties are not allowed.
- *All treats, if food, must be store bought with an ingredient listing and individually wrapped.
- **This is due to the number of food allergies we have at our school.**



Cakes and Cupcakes are not allowed.

- *Treats need to be dropped off by 12pm to the office and will be taken to your child's classroom for them to pass out the last 10 minutes of our day.
- *Birthday party invitations for a later date can be handed out at the end of the day as well, but there must be one for the whole class. If only a few are invited, those are not to be handed out at school.



Forgotten Items and Lunch Drop Off Guidelines

In regards to forgotten items, we are attempting to minimize classroom interruptions and encourage responsibility. At the same time, we do realize things get forgotten.

We will no longer be calling students out of class to get these items. Teachers will send students down at appropriate times to pick up their items.

Lunches will be set on an appropriate table in the foyer. **ALL ITEMS MUST BE LABELED.** Any lunches not picked up will be thrown away at 4pm each day. The office staff is not responsible for any lunches that are left.

We highly encourage you to put a small balance of money on your child's lunch account in case a lunch is not brought to them. Your students' nutritional needs are most important and we will send them to the cafeteria to purchase a tray of food.

Cafeteria Behavior Guidelines

All students are expected to use proper manners when eating their lunch. This includes being courteous to students and adults. It also means that throwing or any other misuse of food/drinks is not allowed.

Dear Hillside Parents:

We strive to have a safe and orderly arrival and dismissal of students each day. To ensure that safety please observe the following

Guidelines:

- Both drive through areas are one lane only for morning traffic. Please pull past the cross walk to allow as many students as possible to be dropped off and to keep traffic moving. We are a neighborhood school and as traffic backs up our neighbors are sometimes blocked in their driveways and alley ways. Please be mindful of this as you are dropping off.
- If you are using the drive through, you must remain in your car. If you are walking your student to the doors please park in the parking lot or on the side of the street.
- PLEASE BE MINDFUL of the cross walk areas as they extend all the way through both lanes. Students are walking in these areas to meet their cars. **DO NOT PULL THROUGH THIS AREA WITH YOUR CAR!!!**
- Refrain from using your cell phone. It is a \$200 fine!
- **The parking lot is not a drive through or drop off area. If you use the parking lot, please park and walk your child across the crosswalk.**
