Cost: \$55.00 per child for U8 and below and \$60.00 per child for U10 and above. All players will receive a t-shirt. All U6 players will receive medals at the end of the season. U8 – U16 teams placing first or second at season end will receive a trophy, all other players will receive a medal at the end of the season.

Season: Begins **March 23rd** and ends on or before **May 4th**. All games will be played at 4th Ave. and Brown Road Soccer Fields. Games will be played on Saturday and weekday evenings.

Evaluations: Evaluations for all U8, U10, U13, and U16 players will be on **March 2nd for new players this season**. The purpose of the evaluations is to give the coaches a better idea of different attributes and abilities of each child. **ALL** children, regardless of their skill level, will be selected for a team. Players in the U6 divisions will not participate in evaluations. **Age groups are based upon player's birth year.**

The schedule for evaluations is:

REMINDER: For the Evaluations, each child will need the following: t-shirt and shorts, shoes, shin guards, ball, and WATER.

Equipment: We will provide the game t-shirt for your child. You will need to provide shorts, socks, cleats, shin guards, and a ball. Shin guards must be covered entirely by the sock. Soccer shoes are recommended, but any shoe WITHOUT a toe cleat is acceptable. The U8 and below players will play with a **size 3 ball**. The U10 players will play with a **size 4 ball**. The U13 and U16 players will play with a **size 5 ball**. PDSA will provide game balls for all divisions.

Teams: The coaches will draft their teams immediately after the evaluations. They will call you to set up practice times. If you have not been notified by your child's coach by March 9th, call your division commissioner.

Rules: Our goals are fun, sportsmanship, and teaching. The coaches are volunteers, and the referees aren't paid enough to put up with abuse. No parent is allowed to confront a ref at anytime all questions need to be brought to the commissioner. If a parent is asked to leave due to unsportsmanlike conduct, their child will leave the game as well. We have had very few problems. We thank you, the parents, for this. For your child's safety, please remove all jewelry before practice or games.

Photos: If you desire a team picture, please ask your coach to set up a photo day.
